WIRE SERVICE AFFECTED.

Aurora Borealis Causes Radio and Telegraph Interruptions.

Electric currents caused by the Aurora Borealis interrupted telegraph service into this city last night, particularly from the north. Radio communication was also interfered with.

Local Western Union and Postal Telegraph officials said that messages sent from points in the middle west toward New York were completely lost at times due to the currents caused by the "Northern Lights." The interruption continued at intervals for several hours.
