### **AN EXHIBITION IN THE SKY.**

Chicago, Sept. 19.—How many people noticed the exceptionally beautiful display of the Aurora Borealis last evening?

Appearing first, to my observation, about 10:15 p. m., as a broad greenish glow extending from the eastern to the northwest horizon, it reached its height of beauty at 10:30 p. m. with a rapid swirling nebular spiral movement of rainbow hues emanating from a central focal point directly overhead.

It was the most wonderful display of this beautiful natural phenomena I have ever seen.

By 10:45 p. m. the magnificent central display had spread out and broken up into individual shafts of light resembling an army maneuver involving thousands of powerful searchlights.
