

Spots on Sun Disrupt Phones

NEW YORK, Dec. 16. (AP)—
Electrical disturbances, attributed by some engineers to sun spots or the Aurora Borealis, played hob with communications lines throughout the country today.

A spokesman for the American Telephone & Telegraph Co. said the disturbances hampered or interrupted service for short periods from coast to coast, with the greatest amount of difficulty in the West. A.T.&T. said it expects them to continue for 36 hours.

Federal Officials to Plan San Diego Aqueduct
