AURORA BOREALIS DISPLAY

Sky Show Seen Over Wide Area but in Only Parts of City

A display of aurora borealis was visible last night in parts of Manhattan, the Bronx and Queens. But it could not be seen at the Battery, the Weather Bureau said.

The bureau had reports that the aurora was also seen in the New England states, northern Pennsylvania, northern New Jersey and upstate New York, as well as in Wisconsin and Michigan.

The display started at about 10:30 P. M. and continued past midnight.

No effects to communications of the major broadcasting companies, Western Union or The Associated Press were reported by the electrical phenomenon.
