Uranium and Aurora

Blamed in Plane Crash TOULOUSE, France, Jan. 24

th—Air force experts today blamed uranium deposits in the Pyrenees and the rarely seen aurora borealis for the crash of a French air force DC3 on a mile-high peak, with

the probable loss of the nine men aboard. They said the uranium threw the plane's compass and other navigational instruments out of kilter, and blamed disturbing magnetic storms on the northern lights.
