

# **SOLAR EXPLOSION CAUSES SHOW OF NORTHERN LIGHTS**

Washington, Nov. 13 (UPD)—

A mammoth gas explosion on the sun is giving parts of North America a rare and spectacular show of the aurora borealis. It also is causing disrupting global radio communications.

Astronomers figure the red, orange, and green lights will flit thru the sky thru tomorrow night as a result of the solar explosion spotted yesterday by observers near Alamogordo, N. M.

Solar radiation bombarding the earth's atmosphere at speeds of 3,000 feet a second caused magnetic storms around the world that washed out radio communications. Reports show that the colorful northern lights were seen as far south as Miami, north to Caribou, Me., and west to Indianapolis.
